- 1 The name of the group is Kerora Nai Taung, which means let's build Kerora together.
- 2 This group consists of 30 thirty people who are men and women who live in Kerora hamlet. This group will develop a nature tourism service business.
- 3 The Kerora Mai Taung group has agreed on the SOP for guiding and revenue sharing.
group income. The minimum price of guiding services obtained by a guide is Rp. 100,000
- 4 The price for guiding the Kerora trekking trail to Wae Wako is IDR. 200,000 and the Wae Dese trekking trail Rp. 400,000 with a distribution percentage of 50% guide, 30% Komodo National Park Multipurpose Cooperative, 20% group and 10% conservation fund.
- 5 Agreed on the need for conservation activities in the form of village clean-ups scheduled once a week in mutual cooperation.

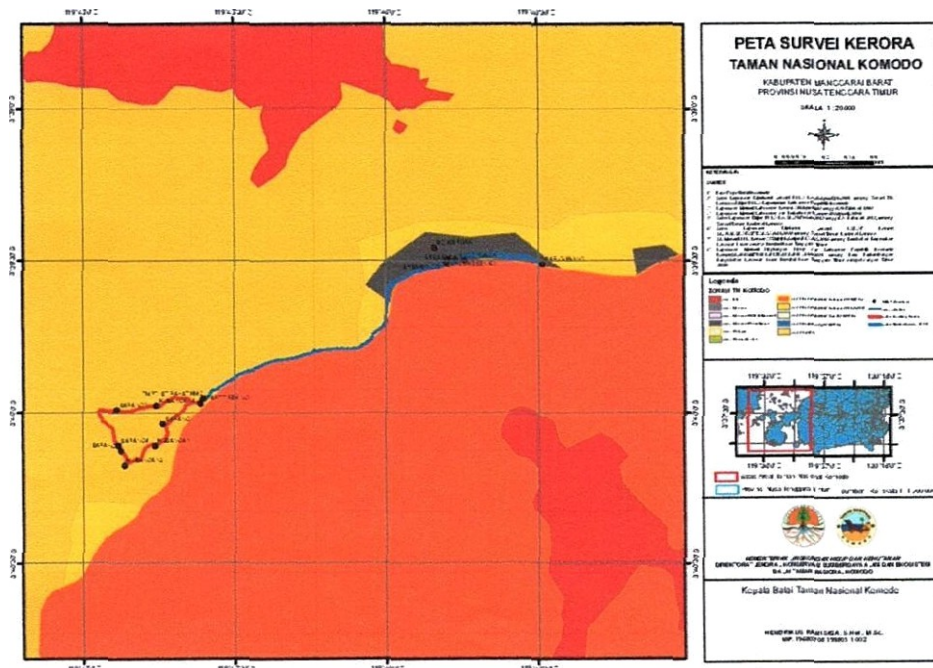
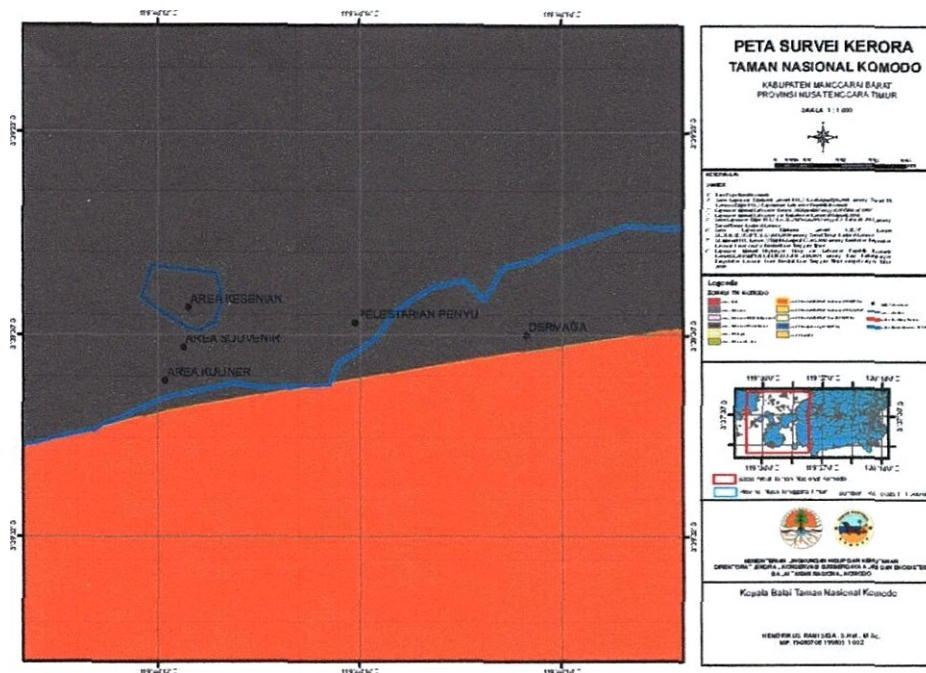


Figure 1. Mapping of Wae Dese trekking trails and the potential of Kerora hamlet

The village head hopes that through this group, the community can benefit from tourism activities and improve welfare. In addition, the Pasir Panjang Village Head wants a sustainable assistance program, both in terms of economic assistance and increasing the capacity of its human resources, because if it is not accompanied, it is worried that it will not run properly according to applicable regulations or even stop and be neglected later. Thus, the involvement of Komodo National Park and Inflores in the future will always be needed so that Kerora Hamlet can develop well in terms of ecotourism and can increase the economic value of the community.
