Coordination of Forest Security and Support for Forest Security Operations and Synergy of

In the Komodo National Park Area with the West Nusa Tenggara Regional

I. BASIS

II. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this activity is to coordinate the follow-up of operation plans supported by the Directorate of Forest Protection and Security in conservation areas, as well as to plan strategic actions in order to implement the operation. The objectives of this activity are:

1. Establish communication between the Komodo National Park Office and the West Nusa Tenggara Regional Police (POLDA);
2. Planning operations to be carried out in the Komodo National Park area together with the West Nusa Tenggara Regional Police (POLDA);
3. Obtain outputs from the Coordination results so that later it can be used as an effective strategic operation model and can be implemented in the Komodo National Park area.

V. Conclusion

There are several conclusions, namely:

1. The Head of the NTB Regional Police (Kapolda) supports the implementation of a joint operation to arrest deer poachers carried out by unscrupulous people from Bima Regency in the Komodo National Park area;
2. The operation plan will be carried out in a captured manner for the deer poachers and will involve NTB Police if the suspects flee to Bima District;
3. It is planned as the ultimate operation to eradicate poachers from Bima District by conducting a curbing operation of assembled weapons in the jurisdiction of NTB Police because it is suspected that the assembled weapons are used to hunt deer;
4. In addition to prosecution of the owner of the assembled firearms, it is necessary to prosecute the owner of the assembled firearms.
unscrupulous state officials who traded gun ammunition, because it was suspected that the ammunition used was organic ammunition left over from shooting practice;
5. The Komodo National Park Center will build an Integrated Post in the western part of Komodo Island which is philosophically correlated with the Panopticon Theory where people can be controlled if they believe that they are under continuous surveillance even though no one is watching. This Integrated Post will not only be a symbol, but will be maximized by providing a proportional portion to conduct surveillance on the West side of Komodo Island, so that later it can reduce and even eliminate the intention of criminals in the forestry sector.
6. The implementation of the operation plan in addition to involving NTB POLDA will also involve NTT POLDA which will begin with a joint coordination meeting;
7. Korwil KLHK NTB Region provides support related to the implementation of joint operations, because in addition to the Komodo National Park area, deer hunting also often occurs in NTB, so that with the operation of controlling assembled firearms, it can stop deer hunting activities in the NTB region;
8. The Head of the NTB KSDA Center also provided support regarding the operation plan, and suggested that the operation not only be carried out against deer poachers but also fishers with explosives that often occur in the waters of the Bima Regency area;

1.
